Dear Parent/Carer

All pupils will be provided with their Learner Profile by the end of November. A guide on how to maximise the use of this document has been emailed to all parents and can also be found on our SharePoint (the communications section). The learner profile is a paper record of all the positive and negative house points from the last nine weeks of school. Staff regularly identify and record key learning skills and characteristics both inside and outside of lessons rewarding house points where appropriate. We are able then to share these with pupils and parents to elicit purposeful conversations to allow every single pupil to improve and be the best that they can be. Developing key learning attributes is clearly a shared priority, but we also want to recognise the fantastic contributions made by our pupils outside of lessons.
