Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you that at the request of the School Council the last day of term will be a non-uniform day in order to support the School Council chosen charities.

The minimum donation should your child choose not to wear uniform will be £1. They are of course welcome to donate more. Please see below our rules for the day:

- No hats or coats to be worn in school.
- No bare midriffs.
- No excessively short shorts.
- Leggings to be dark or a long top/shorts worn over them. They can be worn under shorts.
- No open toed shoes.
- No excessively short skirts.
- Make up and jewellery rules apply as normal, including no nail varnish.
- No strappy tops.

If students arrive at school not adhering to the rules they may be sent home to change. If this is not possible they may be kept in isolation from the rest of the School. It is important students remember that despite not wearing uniform, what they do wear needs to be appropriate for a school environment.

If all students follow these rules and contribute £1 or more each, we anticipate well over £1000 being raised.

The last day of term will be a shorter day. Year 12 will finish at 12.15pm. Years 7 – 10 will have lunch followed by afternoon registration and will then be dismissed from 1.00pm.
