

Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Arrangements for Year 13 initial LFD Testing – Tuesday, 4th January

I am writing to provide further information about the Lateral Flow Device (LFD) Test that is available to your child, with consent, as they return to the school site for the Spring Term. The government are encouraging all students in secondary school to take one on site test before beginning lessons at school.

The LFD test is available on Tuesday, 4th January, before the return of all Year 13 pupils on Wednesday, 5th January. In order to manage access to the Test Site, each Tutor Group in Year 13 has been allocated an arrival time at school – please see the table below for when your child should attend for their LFD test.

Please note the following information:

- If your child has had COVID within the last 90 days, they should not be doing LFD tests as they can give a false positive result – if this is the case for your child they should not attend for testing
- Your child should arrive at school at their designated time and report to the Main School Hall where they will be registered
- They may wear their own clothes— they do not need any other equipment with them
- Your child should attend the school site for their test and then return straight home
- A parent/carer must have completed the online consent form available on the School's website before the test can take place – consent provided previously is still valid. Consent can be withdrawn at any time using the facility on the School's website
- You will receive notification from the NHS of your child's test result via the email address that we have on file for you. Unlike last year, you no longer need to register the test result yourself. If your child tests positive then you will also be contacted by the School. In the event of a positive test, please book a PCR test for your child. They should isolate for 10 days if the PCR tests positive

We look forward to welcoming your child back to school and they should attend for their first full day following the Sixth Form dress code. Please email any queries you may have about the LFD process to office@darrickwood.bromley.sch.uk
