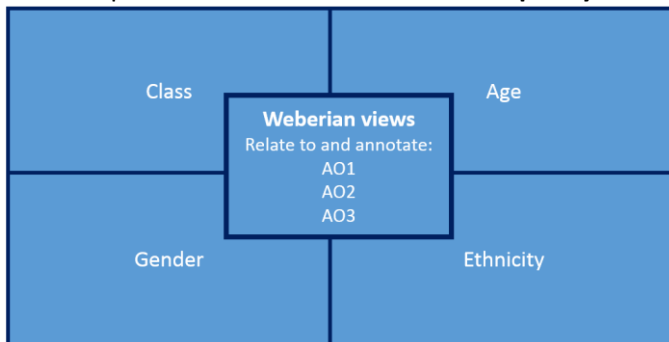

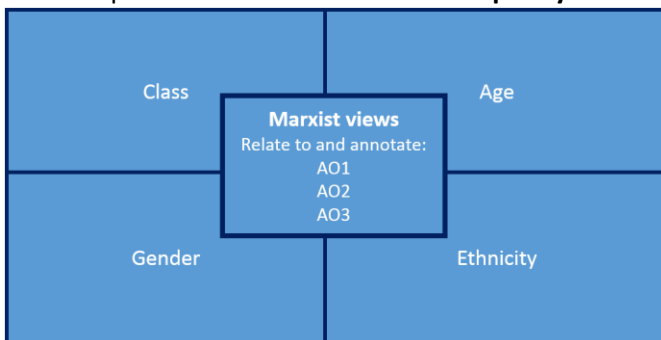

Mind map **Weberian theories of social inequality**:



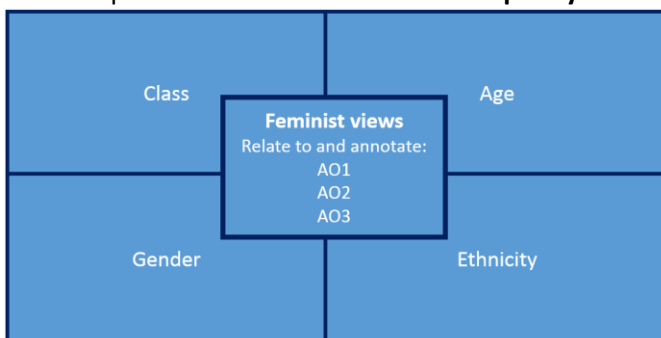

Mind map **Marxist theories of social inequality**:



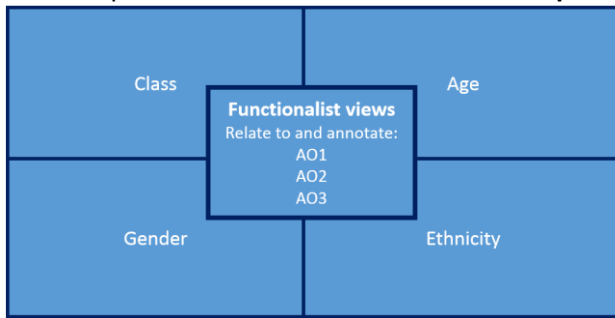

Mind map **Feminist theories of social inequality**:



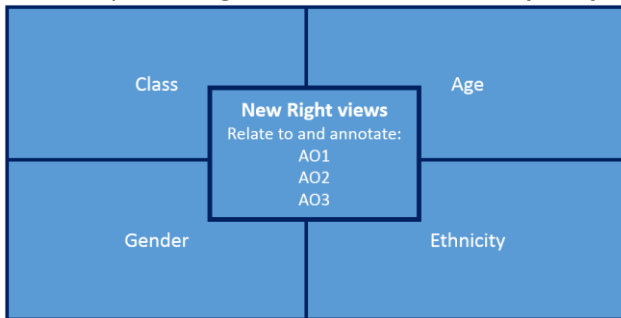

Mind map **Functionalist theories of social inequality:**



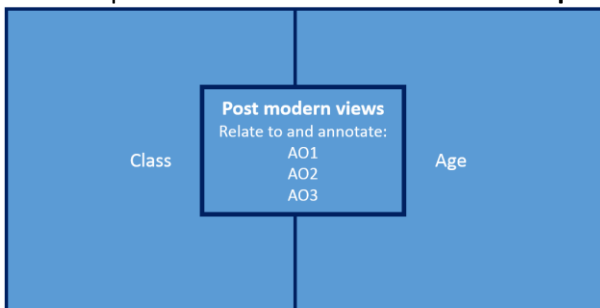
